# **Assignment Description**

IFC PPP Transaction Advisory is working with the Government in a country of the Levant region on a project to attract private investment through a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) for the construction of hazardous waste treatment facilities on a brownfield landfill and the long-term operation of the treatment and disposal site. IFC will provide advisory services to the Ministry of Environment to engage the private sector to clean-up and remediate the existing hazardous waste landfill, build and finance new treatment facilities and operate the site in the long-run, in accordance with international best practices. The future concessionaire shall develop the new facilities through a phased approach over the term of the concession to cope with the forecasted industrial and medical waste volumes over the next few decades.

The IFC team will conduct a legal, technical, commercial, financial, environmental and social (E&S) review of the Project to help develop a robust PPP transaction structure and appropriate risk allocation for the public and private sectors. Accordingly, IFC is looking to appoint a Technical Consultant to:

i. conduct a detailed technical, commercial and E&S due diligence to assess the best options to structure the Project (Phase 1); ii. help market the Project to investors, prepare technical inputs to prequalification and tender documents, and assist in the negotiation as well as evaluate and select the winning bidder (Phase 2).
