RFP for Four Laning of Tuljapur – Ausa (including Tuljapur Bypass) Section of NH-361 from km 0.000 to km 55.835 (Existing Chainage: km 416.000 to km 470.000) under NHDP Phase-IV in the State of Maharashtra on Hybrid Annuity Mode.

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 361 including the section from km 0.000 to km 55.835 (Existing Chainage: km 416.000 to km 470.000) (approx. 67.428 km). The Authority had resolved to augment the existing road from km 0.000 to km 55.835 (Existing Chainage: km 416.000 to km 470.000) (approximately 67.428 km) on the Tuljapur - Ausa (Including Tuljapur Bypass) section of National Highway No. 361 (hereinafter called the “NH 361”) in the State of Maharashtra by Four-Laning thereof (the “Project”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “DBOT Annuity” or “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded.
